Overview

The Level 3 NVQ Certificate in Advice and Guidance (RQF) is a UK OFQUAL accredited 100% online, competency-based qualification for practitioners who work directly with clients, disseminating information, advice and guidance (IAG). The purpose of this qualification is to help learners develop the knowledge, understanding and skills necessary to thrive in an advisory capacity improving the workplace quality, directly interacting and communicating with clients, supporting them with making informed decisions for their education and career. This IAG course will also help you if you are already working as, or wish to become career advisors/ career counsellors. These specialist skills are sought after in a growing number of industries and are commonly required for college tutors and other support roles. Scope of this Qualification

Assessment and Verification

Practical Requirements

This course is assessed through a series of tutor marked assignments in addition to practical work, which is assessed in the workplace. The placement will need to occur in a work setting, allowing you to demonstrate your skills and progression to gather evidence in the provision of advice and guidance, which must be supervised by a qualified supervisor/ advisor/ counsellor willing to attest to a range of activities undertaken by you and to oversee your practical evidence gathering.

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
