## Overview

Level 3 Award in Education and Training is ideal if you wish to pursue a career in education and training. Formerly known as the Level 3 Award in Preparing to Teach in the Lifelong Learning Sector (PTLLS course), this industry-standard foundation qualification is best for those looking to teach and train. Most training centres in the UK would expect you to have a Level 3 AET qualification before you start to teach in the FE and HE sectors. You are not required to have any prior qualification or experience to start this Level 3 AET course. ## Duration and Delivery

The course, which is carefully devised and curated, is to be delivered in the span of 3 days. On the first day, **Unit 1** of the course will be thoroughly explained, including the roles and responsibilities of teachers/trainers, the training cycle, working with other professionals, legislation, and promoting equality and diversity. Through interactive activities like role plays, class discussions, and a quiz, learners gain hands-on experience and develop essential skills for effective teaching and training.

**Unit 3** of the course will be thoroughly discussed on the second day. The discussion includes assessment types, methods, their purpose, and how to adapt to these various assessment methods to meet each learner's individualised needs. This will be followed by several activities and Q/A sessions.

Specifically, they are expected to deliver a 15-minute micro-teaching session. The remaining 45 minutes will be dedicated to observing micro-teaching sessions conducted by other learners or peers.

## Practical Requirements

You must be involved in at least one hour of micro-teaching. For this purpose, you must deliver at least a 15-minute micro-teaching session that is observed and assessed. For the other 45 minutes, you will observe the micro-teaching sessions of fellow participants.
